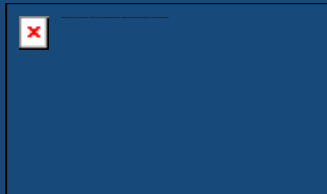

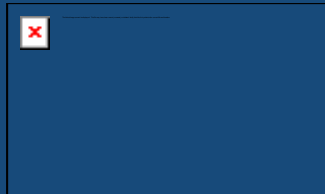

Q How long have each of you been part of the Education Committee?

A M: Since it started at CORD AA17
E: This is my first year on the committee

Q Chairing a committee is a big commitment, what advice do you have for others who are thinking about joining a committee but are apprehensive?

A M: CORD is one of the most welcoming organizations. If you've said yourself "I think this would be better if we did..." then that is the committee to sign up for. Your ideas and energy are what make committee's great. It's not too much time if you enjoy what you are doing and are working with great people.
E: There's certainly work involved, but there's also a lot of support from other committee members and the board. We're also very focused on creating tangible products from our work, which I find particularly rewarding.

Q What is the Education Committee currently working on/towards?

A M&E: We have four major goals this year.
1. Publication of "white papers" on best practices in resident education
2. Development of a certificate program for faculty and fellows interested in program leadership roles
3. Development of an online educational resource focused on faculty development and program administration
4. Establishment of an education consult service to serve as a resource for programs nation-wide

Q You both came up with a release schedule for the sessions recorded during the conference in Florida, how do you think these recordings will help CORD members?

A There were so many outstanding presenters and sessions at CORD AA17, and one of the hardest parts of the actual meeting is that it is impossible to attend all of the sessions. We hope this repository will help maximize the impact of our presenters to benefit CORD members throughout the year. Recording and releasing key sessions will provide a way for CORD members to watch sessions they would have liked to attend, re-watch sessions that had particular merit for their positions or share with colleagues.
