
# **Innovative Curriculum 560:**

# **Open Your Eyes: Poverty Simulation in Residency Training**

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### **Change practice?**

Integrating a poverty simulation into residency training can help create insight into the chronic crisis that consumes so many working poor families that present to the ED for medical care.

#### **Teaching Point 1:**

A poverty simulation experience can be an important intervention to help mitigate burnout and increase residents' sense of meaningful work.

### **Teaching Point 2:**

The poverty simulation provides an alternative to lecture-based instruction allowing residents to delve into difficult situations they will likely encounter during their training.

#### **Teaching Point 3:**

The poverty simulation breaks down stereotypes by allowing participants to step into the real-life situations of others in a creative, interactive session.
