<b>How this info can change current practice</b>	Provide a single, very convenient portal of entry to all things residency. Without any app building experience, you can take advantage of a handful of app building websites to create an app that can include: your program calendar, recorded lectures, educational files, online submission forms (ex. for interesting EKGs, images, M&M cases etc.), a clinical chat room, quizzes, surveys, and more. Empower your residents (or applicants!) to connect to your program's unique content the way they want to whenever they want to.
<b>Major teaching point #1</b>	Lack of app building savvy is no longer a barrier to having an app.
<b>Major teaching point #2</b>	Your residents can learn from you from the comfort of any location with internet access.
<b>Major teaching point #3 (as needed)</b>	Too many fractured points of program contact hinder a program's online presence – using a single app as a unified entry point to increase engagement.
