 - Spotlight on a consultant, a staff member and a family member
- Applicant handout
 - Non-exclusive list of residents
 - e.g. married, with kids, with dogs, with neither etc
 - A way to highlight diversity, (without being exclusionary)
- Billboard of buddies
 - Pictures of a family member, kid, pet, partner etc.
 - Play a matching game
 - Friendly faces at work that share something about you
